- The board discussed the club's belated response to the proposed question and answer session and will continue to press the club for a response.

- The possibility of establishing a junior branch of the Trust was discussed. The Trust will be seeking to grow junior membership with a view to encouraging young supporters to engage.
- An update on the Trust's involvement in the My City, My Shirt initiative was provided.
- The Trust will seek to discuss season card renewals with the club.
- The Campaign for Real Living Wage was discussed in relation to the club.
